FLORAL REGULATIONS  
Effective 6/1/2022

The following regulations were created to keep guests and staff safe while we work diligently to maintain a beautiful park like setting. Please help us keep our park safe and beautiful by following the Floral Regulations below.

This policy includes Upright Monuments, Flat Memorials and Niches.

1. For safety purposes, Glass, Rocks, Fire Ignitable Items, Balloons on a string, Statues, Trinkets, or any other type of Commemorative Items are NOT ALLOWED at any time.
2. Fresh Cut Flowers, Artificial Flowers, Plastic or Wooden Pinwheels and American Flags are ALLOWED year-round in an approved cemetery vase only. Private plantings of any kind will not be permitted and will be removed.
3. Flower vases must be approved by the cemetery office. Please remove any stagnant water and turn the vase upside down when not in use. This will maximize its longevity and discourages mosquitoes using the dirty water to propagate.
4. Holiday Decorations and potted plants will be permitted in approved cemetery vases or on the marker 10 days before and two 2 days after for the following Holiday's; Valentines Day, St. Patricks Day, Easter, Mothers Day, Memorial Day, Fathers Day, Fourth of July, Halloween, Veterans Day and Thanksgiving. Due to the three major holidays in December, Hanukkah, Christmas and Kwanzaa, decorations may remain on the graves during this month.
5. All flowers and decorations will be removed four times a year. (Visit [www.nrgcemetery.com](http://www.nrgcemetery.com) for the current Floral Removal Schedule or visit our office during office hours)
6. Floral items and other types of decorations are not to be secured to headstones or markers.
7. Do not place anything of value (sentimental or otherwise) on grave(s). The Cemetery District will not be held responsible for any items that turn up damaged or missing. This includes flower can vases and inserts.
8. The Cemetery retains the right to remove and not replace already existing trees, shrubs and other plantings that through growth encroach on lot owner's property, becomes unsightly, diseased, damaged by accident or weather or have become a hazard to the general public.
9. Decorations of any kind are not allowed in our trees, shrubs and other plantings. This is to prevent damage and stunting of growth.
10. Funeral Flowers from a recent service will be allowed to remain on the grave 5 days after burial.
