G. MANGERS REPORT

- 1. Operations Update
 - a. The Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Audit took place on February 15th to 17th. Everything went well and there were no concerns. The Auditor will attend the Workshop Meeting on March 14th.

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- b. The installation of the new flag pole at Ophir has been completed. In addition to the pole, a concrete pad was poured around the base and roped off around three sides to create a controlled entrance for safety purposes. Rob plans to bring in some plants to go around the flag pole and a solar spotlight to light up the flag at night. In addition three steps were installed to make access to the Cemetery easier.
- c. Grounds Crew were able to remove the root ball from the very large tree that was blown down in Block 2 and filled in the hole that was left. The coping that was affected has been put back in place. Now just need to reconnect some pipes and clean up the area.
- d. The Dodge was taken to Kniesel to evaluate the damage to the bumper. They provided a quote of \$9,700.00. The truck was then taken to Auburn Crysler Dodge Jeep and Ram to diagnose the engine issue that Jaymee reported but they were unable to find anything.
